Rail Ridge, Prineville, District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 10). Fifty-one miles northwest of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs, torching and long-range spotting. Numerous structures, communication infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Devils Knob, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). IMT is also managing the Milepost 98 fire. Five miles southeast of Tiller, OR. Timber. Active fire behavior with spotting, running and backing. Structures threatened. Evacuations in effect.

* **Milepost 98**, Pendleton Unit, ODF. One mile north of Canyonville, OR. Light slash and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Road closures in effect.

Wiley Flat, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). Thirty-one miles southeast of Prineville, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with group torching, flanking and backing. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Shoe Fly, Prineville Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 1). Forty-five miles northeast of Prineville, OR. Brush, grass and timber. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Fossil Complex (3 fires), Fossil Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 2). Two miles northwest of Spray, OR. Grass and timber. Extreme fire behavior with spotting, wind-driven runs and torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 13) and CIMT (NW Team 2). IMTs are also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and backing. Communication and transportation infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, flanking and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Homestead Complex (4 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 8). Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Diamond Complex (2 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Copperfield, Klamath Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 3). Five miles southeast of Chiloquin, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 12). IMT is also managing the Sandstone fire. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber, brush and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Structures, energy and transportation infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sandstone, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Brush, closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Buck Creek, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10) mobilizing. Thirty miles southwest of Silver Lake, OR. Timber and medium slash. Active fire behavior with flanking, backing and isolated torching.

Bowman Well, Lakeview District. BLM. Twenty miles northeast of Silver Lake, OR. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, smoldering and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations and area closures in effect.

Lane 1, East Lane Unit, ODF. CIMT (AK Team 1). Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and light slash. Moderate fire behavior with backing and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Huckleberry Ridge, Pacific Cascade Region, DNR. Twenty miles south of Pe Ell, WA. Heavy slash and timber. Active fire behavior with backing, spotting and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Sage Hen, Burns District, BLM. Ten miles west of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping.

Crazy Creek, Ochoco NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northeast of Paulina, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Last report unless significant activity occurs.

Battle Mountain Complex (2 fires), Pendleton Unit, ODF. Eight miles north of Ukiah, OR. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened.

Ruby, North Cascades NP, NPS. Thirty-two miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with single tree torching, creeping and backing. Area and trail closures in effect.

Williams Mine, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Four miles northwest of Trout Lake, WA. Brush, timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with group torching and short-range spotting. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Easy, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seventeen miles west of Mazama, WA. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Moderate fire behavior with torching and uphill runs. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Active fire behavior with group torching, short-range spotting and uphill runs. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Pioneer, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. Started on private land 10 miles southeast of Stehekin, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Firestone**, Deschutes NF, USFS. Twenty-one miles north of Fort Rock, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

*** Flat Top**, Deschutes NF, USFS. Ten miles north of Fort Rock, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, backing and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Lava, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 1) mobilizing. Twelve miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with crowning, long-range spotting and wind-driven runs. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wapiti, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 7). Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, torching and spotting. Numerous structures and several communities threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Boulder, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (RM Team 3). IMT is also managing the Snag, Goat and Dollar fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with running, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Snag, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with backing, group torching and spotting. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Boise NF, USFS. Eleven miles southeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dollar, Boise NF, USFS. Eighteen miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, isolated torching and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Fish Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 2). Twenty-two miles southeast of Moran, WY. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and long-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red Rock, Salmon-Challis NF, USFS. Fifteen miles west of Salmon, ID. Timber and light slash. Active fire behavior with group torching, running and long-range spotting. Structures threatened. Area closures in effect.

Middle Fork Complex (2 fires), Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 5). Nine miles east of Garden Valley, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and group torching. Several communities threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Chimney, Eastern Supervisory Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. CIMT (SW Team 4). Nine miles northwest of Fairfield, ID. Brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, torching and spotting. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Predictive Services Discussion:

The low moving out of the Great Basin will weaken, with the thunderstorms coming to an end. This will flatten the ridge of high pressure over the Central Rockies. High temperatures in the Inland Northwest will remain above normal but will only get into the lower 90s. Farther south across the Central Valley and into Arizona, the heat wave will continue with widespread temperatures of 100 to 110 degrees. RH of 5 to 20% will remain in place across much of the Intermountain West and into the western High Plains. Overnight recoveries will continue to be poor, 20 to 30%. Winds across much of the Intermountain West will be 10 to 15 mph out of the west to southwest, with gusts 20 to 25 mph, and some stronger gusts of 20 to 30 mph across the Northern Rockies and the northern Great Basin. Any existing fire, and additional holdovers, will likely see increasing activity with the winds, and with poor overnight recoveries possibly continuing to burn through the overnight. Some remaining moisture in the Four Corners could still result in isolated mixed wet/dry thunderstorms.

Some light rain remains possible from the eastern Great Lakes into the Northeast as a low continues to slowly progress eastward, along with some better rain expected across Florida. A tropical system developing in the western Gulf will bring some increasing moisture into the Texas coast. Outside of this activity expect much of the eastern US to remain dry, with lower RH of 20 to 30% from the eastern High Plains across the Midwest and into the Ohio and Tennessee valleys. Winds will be light.
