Please make sure individuals selected are rested and ready for an assignment duration of 24-30 days. If individuals are reassigned from incidents, provide for rest and recuperation days prior to this military assignment. Individuals must be able to travel on or about Friday August 16, 2024, to a yet to be determined incident location.
